AMAN CHAUDHARY, J.

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for setting aside the impugned order dated 16.10.2019, Annexure P-2 passed by the trial Court in FIR No. 153 dated 18.06.2018, Annexure P-1 registered under Section 61 of the Excise Act, 1914 at Police Station Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda whereby the bail bonds and surety bonds of the petitioner has been cancelled.
2. This Court vide order dated 10.08.2022 had granted an opportunity to the petitioners to surrender before the Court within a period of 10 days as undertaken by them, in such eventuality, they were to be admitted to interim bail. Learned counsel had sought 10 additional days for the petitioners to surrender as noticed in order dated 09.02.2023, which was granted. Today the learned counsel for the petitioners pleads no instructions.
3. On the other hand, learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Baljinder Singh submits that the petitioners have not surrendered.
4. Despite granting sufficient time, the petitioners have not surrendered before the Court. It appears that they have scant regard for the orders passed by this Court.
5. In view of the above, present petition is dismissed.
