Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short “Cr.P.C”) for issuance of direction to the official respondents to inquire into the crime of forgery & cheating committed with petitioner & his family members by respondents No.4 to 6.

On 05.12.2013, this Court passed the following order:-

“Reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Rajender Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Jagadhri (Yamunanagar), has already been filed and para 4 of the same reads as under:-

“4- That in view of submission made above, it is clear that the complaint of the petitioner was duly inquired. No cognizable offence is found made out as it has been found that the matter is dispute was of civil nature and there is dispute of money transaction. As such no ground to register a criminal case against respondent no 4 to 6 has been found. It is also worth submitting that the petitioner has liberty to file a complaint before the competent court.”

Since there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner; therefore, purely in the interest of justice, posted for 06.12.2023.

2. In view of the factual position noticed here-in-above, Id. Counsel, on instructions from petitioner, wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take recourse of remedy available under law before Court concerned.
