By way of this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C, petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.340 dated 03.10.2021 registered under Sections 379-B, 34 IPC at Police Station Sector 6 Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

Allegations in the FIR are that on 02.10.2021 at 08:30 PM, three unknown boys after causing injuries to the complainant – Ravinder snatched golden chain of 5 tolas after giving beatings to him. It is submitted by the petitioner that co-accused Dinesh has already been allowed bail by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-27446 of 2022 (O&M) on 30.06.2022. Case of the petitioner is on the same footing as he is also not named in the FIR. As per the custody certificate placed on record, petitioner has undergone actual custody of 1 year and 19 days although four more cases are pending against him but he is on bail in three of the cases.

It is also conceded by learned State Counsel that though charges have been framed but out of 15 witnesses, cited by the prosecution, not even a single witness has been examined so far and thus trial is likely to take time.

Having regard to the aforesaid factual position, but without

commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing personal bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate concerned.
