Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.173 dated 30.3.2022 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC and Section 61(1)(a) of Excise Act at Police Station Sector 10, District Gurugram.

On the last date of hearing, detailed order was passed whereby interim bail was granted to the petitioner with further direction to join the investigation with the police.

Today, counsel for the petitioner apprised the Court that in compliance of previous order of interim bail, the petitioner joined the investigation with the police. State counsel on instructions from SI Manjit Singh has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by the counsel for the petitioner and further submits that the recoveries are already effected in this case and now the petitioner is not required by the police for further

investigation or custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 12.9.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
