1. The learned counsel for the petitioner(s) seek leave and are permitted to withdraw the extant petitions. The said asked for and granted leave, is groved in the factum, that a statutory appeal is pending before the Competent Appellate Authority concerned.
2. Therefore, the writ petitions are disposed of but with a direction to the learned Appellate Authority concerned, to, keeping in view the age of the statutory appeal, as, subjudice before it, hence make an expeditious decision thereons.

5. Since the main case itself has been decided, thus, all the pending application(s), if any, also stand(s) disposed of.
