By way of this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C, petitioner has prayed for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.65 dated 23.04.2023 registered under Sections 307, 34 IPC (offence under Section 25/54/59 of Arms Act added later on) at Police Station Sector 11, Chandigarh.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that specific allegations in the FIR are against accused Samar alias Nonu, Ankush and Lucky, who are stated to have caused injuries to Sahil. Petitioner is neither named in the FIR nor it is anywhere alleged that three assailants were accompanied by any unknown person. Learned counsel contends that petitioner is being roped into on the allegation that he supplied the weapon to the co-accused.

Notice of motion.

Mr. A.M. Punchhi, Addl. PP, for UT, Chandigarh, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent. Custody certificate has been placed on record.

Learned State Counsel could not refute the afore-said contentions. Petitioner is in custody for the last 02 months and 26 days as per the custody certificate, with no criminal antecedents.

Having noticed the afore-said facts of the case but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate concerned.
