ANOOP CHITKARA, J.

Seeking release of detenue-Mohit from the hands of respondents No.1 to 5, the petitioner has come up before this Court.

2. On instructions, counsel appearing for official respondents submits that the petitioner was summoned by the DGGI Jaipur and yesterday (12.07.2023), she was arrested at noon. Therefore he submits that his detention is not illegal.

3. At this stage, petitioner's counsel submits that initially the petitioner was taken from home and rather kidnapped.

4. Given the above statements, since current detention cannot be said to be illegal, as such, the petitioner is at liberty to file an appropriate application before the concerned Human Right Commission and raise all these pleadings. It is clarified that the petitioner is at liberty to approach other Courts also for appropriate legal remedies including damages.

5. Petition is disposed of in the terms mentioned above. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
