After arguing the matter at length, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to raise all the pleas available to them before the learned trial Court at an appropriate stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

From the record, it is apparent that FIR in the present case was registered on 28.12.2014 and charges were ordered to be framed against the petitioner on 15.06.2015. On an advance notice, learned counsel for the State has informed the Court that only 02 prosecution witnesses out of 17 witnesses have been examined so far. Thus, it is clear that the trial has been unnecessarily delayed. In peculiar circumstances of the case, the learned trial Court is directed to conclude the trial within a period of 08 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Disposed of, accordingly.
