JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to release provident fund of the petitioner for the period 21.08.1965 to 28.11.1970 alongwith interest @ 18%.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that petitioner during 1965 to 1970 worked with respondent -BSF. The petitioner was put under suspension on account of FIR registered against him. The petitioner for the first time made representation to respondent in 2015. The provident fund is right of the petitioner which respondent cannot deny. The respondent in its reply to letters of petitioner has pointed out that it is a 50 years old case and they do not have record.

3. Mr. K.K. Jund, Senior Panel Counsel who on advance notice is present in Court submits that competent authority would look into the grievance of the petitioner and redress the same within a period of 3

months.

4. The present petition stands disposed of in terms of statement of learned counsel for the respondent.
