1. The matter is squarely covered by the decision of this Court in **'Kasturi Lal Saggar vs. DAV College of Education, Hoshiarpur through President, DAV College Managing Committee, Hoshiarpur and others'**

CWP-1227-2001, decided on 20.09.2023.

2. Considering the fact that the dispute can be raised before the Educational Tribunal, the writ petition is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to file an Appeal before the Tribunal. The petitioner would be free to take all the grounds as raised in the present writ petition before the Tribunal.

3. If such an appeal is preferred by the petitioner before the Tribunal within a period of two months henceforth, the same shall be entertained without delving on the question of limitation, keeping in view Section 14 of the Limitation Act, 1963, and it is expected that the Tribunal

shall decide the same on merits expeditiously preferably within a period of 1 year but latest by 2 years.

4. All pending misc. application(s) also stand disposed of.
