This is an application filed under Section 5 of the Limitation Act, seeking condonation of delay of 21 days in filling the instant Review Application.

For the reasons recorded in the application, the delay of 21 days in filing the present Review Application is hereby condoned.

Application stands disposed off.

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The main writ petition was disposed off vide order dated 22nd of May, 2023 in the following terms :

“4. In view of the above factual position wherein the parties have settled the present dispute, present writ petition is disposed off with the following directions:-

(i) The petitioner shall deposit the aforesaid amount of principle within 04 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

(ii) Thereafter, on receiving the amount the respondent-Municipal Council, Kotakpura shall process the claim of the petitioner for pension in accordance with law and make sure that the pension gets released to the petitioner within a period of 8 weeks thereafter along with all arrears.”

2. The present application has been filed seeking modification of the order.

3. During the course of hearing counsel for the parties were allowed to sit together and reconcile the accounts so that the correct amount can be arrived at. Both the counsels are now *ad idem* that the amount mentioned in the order under review is Rs.4,54,424/- whereas the amount mentioned in the application is Rs.3,44,442/- but in fact both the amounts are wrong and the correct amount is Rs.3,59,594/-. It has been further agreed that there is a difference of Rs.94,830/- which shall be refunded by respondents No.3 and 4 to the petitioner within 7 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. Resultantly, Para 4 of the order dated 22nd of May, 2023

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stands modified to the extent that the writ petition is disposed off with the direction to the respondents No.3 and 4 to release an amount of Rs.94,830/- to the petitioner on or before 18th of September, 2023.

5. Review Application stands disposed off accordingly.
