Petitioner is seeking regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C.
in case FIR No.308 dated 17.05.2016 registered at Police Station Rattia,
District Fatehabad under Section 27(A) of the NDPS Act, 1985.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that no
recovery was effected from the petitioner and that only from the
co-accused recovery of 10 grams heroine was effected.

Learned State counsel has placed on record status report by
way of affidavit of DSP Rattia, revealing that case is already at the stage
of recording the statement of accused under Section 313 Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel has further placed on record the
custody certificate revealing the criminal antecedents of the petitioner
inasmuch as one case under Section 302 IPC and various other cases are

pending against him.

Having regard to the factual position as above and also the criminal antecedents of the petitioner, without commenting upon the merits of the case, this Court is not inclined to admit the bail to the petitioner. Hence, the bail of the petitioner is hereby dismissed.
