1. The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.3 and 4 to take appropriate legal action on representation/complaint dated 04.05.2023 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a complaint/representation was given on 04.05.2023 (Annexure P-2) to the police authorities, however, it had failed to yield any response. It has been submitted that the official respondents were under a legal obligation to pass an appropriate order on his complaint.

3. Notice of motion to official respondents only.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Mohit Kapoor, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

5. In the wake of the limited prayer of the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of and respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, is directed to look into the grievance of the petitioner and take appropriate steps, if any required,

under the provisions of law. However, if respondent No.2 does not find any substance in the allegations levelled in the complaint/representation dated 04.05.2023 (Annexure P-2), then the petitioner shall be duly informed as per the parameters laid down by the Supreme Court in ***Lalita Kumari v. Government of Uttar Pradesh & Ors. : 2013 (4) RCR (Criminal) 979.***
