The prayer in the petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of Writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for directing the respondents to make the arrangements for release of detenue namely Gurwinder Singh son of Baljit Singh who is in custody of Rajwinder Kaur.

Reply dated 28.03.2023 has been filed as per which Gurwinder Singh the alleged detenue has travelled to Dubai and is presently residing there. In fact he is evading his arrest as he is an accused in FIR No.587 dated 11.09.2020 under Section 376 and 420 IPC P.S. Sadar Nakodar, Jalandhar registered at the instance of respondent no.4 and in the said case, he has been declared as a proclaimed offender on 23.02.2021.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.
