HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed for the grant of interim bail on the ground that the petitioner is admitted in the hospital and is in coma.

On the last date of hearing, State was directed to file appropriate report qua the medical status of the petitioner so that appropriate order can be passed in the present petition.

Learned State counsel, keeping in view the enquiry done qua the allegations mentioned in the present petition qua the health status, has submitted a report which was sought from the doctor of the Rajindra Hospital, Patiala and on instructions from Dr. Kamalpreet and as per the report dated 18.07.2023, the status of the health of the petitioner is that he only open his eyes spontaneously but is not responding verbally and is not able to consume food orally and is being fed through a tube and the general health condition of the petitioner has been described as poor.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record with their able assistance.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and health condition of the petitioner, as prayed for, the interim bail is granted to the petitioner for a period of three months starting from 21.07.2023 to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate concerned. After the expiry of the said period, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the authorities concerned on 20.10.2023 by 05:00 P.M.
