The instant petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 0055 dated 06.04.2023, registered under Sections 420, 406 and 120-B of IPC, at Police Station Sultanpur Lidhi, District Kapurthala.

Vide order dated 14.07.2023 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, it was directed that no coercive action shall be taken against the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Harish Kumar has submitted that the petitioner is no longer required for investigation.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 14.07.2023 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
