1. The petitioner has filed this Contempt Petition before this Court stating that the order of this Court has not been complied with. It is noticed that the notice of motion has already been issued in this Contempt Petition with directions to the respondents to file a compliance report.

2. An application i.e. CM-17433-CII-2023 has been moved by the learned counsel for the petitioner for placing on record an order passed by the respondent-Corporation dated 08.09.2023 regarding demand of an additional amount. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this demand could not have been made.

3. I have considered the submissions of learned counsel of both the parties.

4. This Court notices that while passing order dated 08.09.2023, the respondents have taken into consideration the order passed by this Court. If the petitioner has any further grievance, he is always free to challenge the said order passed by the respondents before the appropriate forum.

5. No deliberate and willful contempt is made out. This contempt petition is dismissed accordingly. Notices stand discharged.

6. Application CM-17435-CII-2023 is dismissed as having become infructuous.

7. Any other pending application filed in this Contempt Petition shall stand disposed of.
