SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (Oral)

1. The consolidation in the *mohal* concerned was concluded in the year 2010. However, subsequently certain villagers of the *mohal* concerned, are alleged to disturb the survey marks or fixed points, as became erected on the relevant sites concerned, by the Consolidation Authorities concerned. Therefore the aggrieved preferred a complaint before the learned Deputy Commissioner concerned. The later proceeded to mark the said complaint to the Enquiry Officer-cum-Sub Divisional Officer (Civil), Badhra. The latter, as disclosed by Annexure P-1 came to a conclusion that the complaint as instituted by the aggrieved was valid, and, also directed that there should be restoration of the survey marks besides of the boundary pillars, as became erected at the site concerned by the consolidation authorities concerned, who concluded the consolidation operations in the *mohal* concerned, in the year 2010.

2. The above Enquiry Report, as carried in Annexure P-1 remanined unenforced, therefore, the petitioners were led to institute the instant writ petition before this Court claiming therein a mandamus, that

Annexure P-1 be ensured, to be enforced at the instance of all concerned.

4. When the writ petition came up before this Court on 22.09.2022, the hereinafter extracted order was then made :

“ Learned counsel for the State prays for some time to file affidavit of the Deputy Commissioner, Charkhi Dadri to indicate whether status quo ante has been restored pursuant to inquiry report dated 11.07.2022..... ”

5. In pursuance to the making of the above extracted order, the Deputy Commissioner, Charkhi Dadri has placed on record a status report drawn on 10.11.2022, wherein, he has echoed that the order (supra) as made by this Court has been completely complied with.

6. In consonance, the mandamus as prayed for, thus has become completely enforced. Therefore nothing survives in the writ petition and this Court is constrained to close this writ petition.

7. Disposed of accordingly.

8. Since the main case itself has been decided, all the pending application(s), if any, also stand(s) disposed of.
