By way of present petition, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to pay salary due to the petitioner w.e.f. February, 2018.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the response filed by the official respondents, salary was withheld as the petitioner had been served with a charge-sheet. He has placed on record a *xerox* copy of order bearing endorsement No.135-38 dated 30.01.2019 to submit that charge-sheet has been withdrawn, absence period has been treated as a period spent on duty and the amount due shall be disbursed to the petitioner.

In view of the above, prayer made in the petition has become infructuous.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to seek revival of petition in case the due amount is not disbursed.
