Main case

The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.301 dated 30.09.2020 under Sections 289/323/506/120-B of IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Civil Line, Kaithal, District Kaithal (Annexure P-1) and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

On the last date of hearing the following order was passed:-

“None has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

Notice of motion in this case was issued on 07.01.2021 and counsel for the petitioner did not appear on 29.03.2022 and 19.07.2022.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 states that as per order dated 01.08.2022 passed by the Court of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kaithal, the petitioner-Anuj Sharma has died. The said order is taken on record.

Since, learned counsel for the petitioner is not present, in

the interest of justice, adjourned to 30.09.2022.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2-complainant has produced a copy of order dated 17.11.2022 passed by Ld. ACJM, Kaithal wherein trial proceedings have been dropped against petitioner Anuj Sharma keeping in view his death report. He further submits that in view of the above fact, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
