Present petition has been filed challenging the order dated 22.06.2023 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Hisar by which, the prayer of the appellant for the grant of regular bail has been declined.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegations alleged against the appellant are false and frivolous hence, he be granted concession of regular bail.

Learned State counsel submits that as of now, investigation is still in progress and yet to be concluded and the grant of regular bail to the appellant will hamper the investigation.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for appellant submits that the present appeal may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed at this stage but a direction be given to the Investigation Agency to conclude

the investigation in a time bound manner so that the appellant does not suffer indefinite incarceration.

Learned State counsel submits that the investigation will be concluded within a period of four weeks from today and appropriate report will be submitted before the trial Court.

Keeping in view the above, present appeal is disposed of having been not pressed at this stage. However, respondent-State will be bound by their statement recorded hereinabove.
