- [1] Challenge in the petition is to the warrant of attachment, Annexure P/2 dated 23.07.2019 issued by the learned Civil Judge (Jr. Division), Malerkotla in case bearing No. EXE/101/2019 in case titled as Kashmiri Lal vs. Shri Guru Kirpa Rice Mills whereby property of the petitioner was attached.
- [2] Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner had moved an application before the learned Executing Court for release of property from attachment in view of his having offered an alternative property to secure the interest of the decree holder and the said application was accepted, therefore, in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition and same may be disposed of as having become infructuous.
