The prayer under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.83 dated 12.02.2022 under Sections 22(c)/27/61/85 (Section 29 added later on) of the NDPS Act and Section 18(C) and 18-A of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Sirsa.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 17.07.2023 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel has filed status report by way of affidavit of Mr. Ajaib Singh, DSP (HQ), Sirsa, which is taken on record and on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 17.07.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 17.07.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
