1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to the respondents to release his outstanding service benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that petitioner has filed representation (Annexure P-5) which was followed by legal notice dated 10.01.2023 (Annexure P-7), however, respondent-corporation has not replied to representation/legal notice of the petitioner.

3. Mr. Sarvinder Goyal, Advocate, who on advance notice is present in Court for the respondents, submits that competent authority would look into the representation/legal notice of the petitioner and pass appropriate order in accordance with law.

4. Without commenting upon merits of the case and in view of statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, the present

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petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent-authorities to decide the representation/legal notice.
