1. Reply on behalf of respondent has been filed in Court today.

2. In the present petition, the grievance raised by the petitioner is that disciplinary proceedings initiated against him are not being taken to the logical end, which is causing prejudice to him.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondents be directed to conclude the disciplinary proceedings and also decide the grant of salary for the period the petitioner remained suspended in a time bound manner so that petitioner does not suffer any prejudice.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that keeping in view the averments made in the reply, disciplinary proceedings pending

against the petitioner will be finalized within a period of six weeks from the receipt of copy of this order and in case, any benefit is admissible to the petitioner after the conclusion of the disciplinary proceedings, the same will also be extended to the petitioner within a further period of four weeks.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the said statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to avail appropriate remedy in case, petitioner is aggrieved against the final outcome of the enquiry.
