1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 23.08.2013 passed by this Court in CWP-10284-2011.

2. Short reply dated 10.10.2023 by way of affidavit of Jai Krishan Abhir, IAS, Director and Special Secretary, Rural Development Department, Chandigarh, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.

3. Compliance reply by way of affidavit of Ajay Chopra, HCS, Chief Executive Officer, DRDA, Fatehabad, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.

4. Counsel for the respondents submits that as per the compliance affidavit, all the pensionary benefits, as claimed by the petitioner, have been granted in her favour and, therefore, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

5. Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, she would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
