HARSH BUNGER J. (ORAL)

1. Petitioner (R.K. Chaudhary) has filed the present petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for setting aside award dated 21.02.2011 (Annexure P-1), passed by the Presiding Officer, Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court, Patiala, to the extent whereby full back wages to the petitioner have been denied, while holding him entitled to the relief of reinstatement with continuity of service and 50% of the back wages from the date of service of demand notice till reinstatement only. A further prayer has been made to direct respondent No.2 to give full back wages to the petitioner from the date of termination of his services.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per his

instructions, apart from the gratuity, all other payments have been released in favour of the petitioner, and accordingly he does not intend to press the instant petition, however, he may be permitted to avail his remedies before the concerned authority, with regard to the payment of gratuity amount.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as not pressed. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail his remedies before the concerned authority, with regard to the payment of gratuity amount.

4. All pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
