The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the leave encashment, arrears of salary, TA/DA Bills and other pending bills to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has asserted that the RTI reply dated 09.06.2023 and 15.06.2023 has revealed that no departmental proceedings of any nature were pending at the time when the petitioner was superannuated and still for the reasons best known to the respondents, the aforesaid retiral benefits have not been released and have been withheld illegal and arbitrarily.

The petitioner has sought release of the said retiral benefits through the instant petition with the averment that he lastly made a legal notice dated 02.05.2023 within a time bound period alongwith interest @12% per annum from the date it became due till the date of its realisation.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Sandeep Singh Maan, Addl. AG, Haryana

accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1, who undertakes to get the legal notice

decided within a period of one month from today by passing a speaking order, in accordance with law with a copy of order so passed supplied to the petitioner.

In case, the petitioner is found entitled, he shall be paid benefits alongwith interest for the delayed part.

Petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.

Ordered accordingly.
