Through this petition, the petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.138, dated 31.05.2022, registered under Section 323, 354-A, 377, 406, 498-A, 506, 34 IPC at Police Station Civil Lines, Rohtak, District Rohtak.

The FIR has been filed on account of the marital discord between the petitioner and his wife, who were married on 23.11.2018. They were blessed with a baby girl. A careful reading of the FIR shows that the first informant has levelled all sorts of allegations against her in-laws and the family members. The petitioner was hence granted the interim protection.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Renu, admits that on investigation, the names of three accused namely Savita, Deepti and Rajesh have been placed in column no.2 of the chargesheet. It has also been admitted that the petitioner has joined

the investigation and returned the gold ornaments, however, it has been stated that certain articles including clothes have not been returned.

The FIR was registered on 31.05.2022 and the learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has already joined investigation. He further submits that the police report under Section 173 Cr.P.C has been prepared, however, it is yet to be submitted in the court. Thus, as of now, the investigation is also complete.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the interim order is made absolute. In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
