1. This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent No.1 to take action against respondent Nos.2 and 3 for violating policy dated 02.08.2022 (Annexure P-5), with a further prayer for refunding the fee paid by the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of Clause 5 of the University Grants Commission Notification dated 11.04.2023, as per which, a complaint from an aggrieved student relating to the institution can be addressed to the Chairperson of Students's Grievance Redressal Committee and in case of any adverse decision, an appeal can also be filed with the Ombudsperson, thus, the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to avail the said alternative remedy in accordance with law.

3. In view of the above statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
