1. The petitioner has assailed the order dated 21.04.2023 passed by the learned Family Court, Gurgram vide which interim maintenance @ Rs.20,000/- has been awarded in favour of the respondent.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. instituted by the respondent has been dismissed in default on 06.07.2023 and the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
