The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.363 dated 27.04.2023 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 307, 506 IPC, 1860 and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 17.07.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A reply dated 15.10.2023 by way of an affidavit of Mayank Mishra, IPS, Assistant Superintendent of Police, Samalkha, Panipat has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions from ASI Kapil admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 17.07.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and she shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
