The matter has been discussed. Appellant has also come in person. He has stated that correct spelling of his name as per Aadhar Card is Gurjeet Singh and that his bank account is also with this spelling. However, inadvertently, in the appeal, his name has been spelled as Gurjit Singh and hence, he has requested that cheque be prepared by mentioning correct spelling of his name as Gurjeet Singh.

Thus, as agreed, as per statements of the appellant, learned counsel for the appellant and learned counsel for the Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of ₹8,00,000/- (₹ Eight Lakh Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for ₹8,00,000/- in the name of the appellant - Gurjeet Singh son of Shri Jagdish Singh with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 30.10.2023, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this

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amount from the date of this order till payment. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent-Insurance Company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
