The petitioner *inter-alia* prays for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to direct the respondents to promote him to Class-III (Class-'C' post) from Class-IV (Class-'D' post).

As per the service rules, before a candidate is eligible to be promoted to Class-'C' post, he is required to pass a English typing test as well as Punjabi typing test.

Initially, the petitioner was declared pass in the typing test held for both languages, however, subsequently it transpired that the petitioner has in fact, failed in Punjabi typing test.

On 04.03.2022, after hearing the learned counsels representing the parties, the original record was requisitioned which has been produced and examined by the learned counsel representing the petitioner. He admits that the petitioner failed to qualify the typing test in Punjabi language.

In view of the aforesaid position, no ground to issue the writ as prayed for is made out.

Dismissed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
