1. The petitioner is seeking cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to respondent No.2-accused vide order dated 17.01.2022 in case FIR No.0001 dated 04.03.2020 under Sections 498-A/120/120-B of the IPC (Sections 465/468/471 of the IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station NRI, District SBS Nagar.

2. As per office report, notice issued to respondent No.2 has been received back unserved with the report that she has gone abroad to the U.S.A.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions, has submitted that respondent No.2-accused has jumped bail and fled away from India, and as she had not put in an appearance before the Trial Court, her surety in the sum of ₹35 lakhs had been forfeited by the Trial Court on 07.08.2023. In support, learned State counsel has filed a copy of order dated 07.08.2023 which is taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

4. In the wake of the instructions received by the learned

State counsel, the instant petition stands allowed and the concession of anticipatory bail granted to respondent No.2-accused vide order dated 17.01.2022 is cancelled.
