Prayer in the petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent Nos. 1 and 2 to grant the opportunity to the petitioner for conducting her interview by constituting a Interview Board, as she has passed the written examination and scrutiny of her documents has already been done.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the arguing counsel is not well and prays for an adjournment.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner had applied for the post of Trained Graduate Teacher (TGT) English in the terms of advertisement No. 09/2015 issued by respondent No.2-Haryana Staff Selection Commission. Since the petitioner was selected in the Final Result under the SC Category and her name has already been recommended to the concerned Department, the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of the submission made by the learned State counsel, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
