By way of this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C, petitioner has prayed for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.232 dated 21.04.2021 registered under Sections 20/25/29 of NDPS Act, at Police Station Samalkha, Panipat.

Allegations against the petitioner are that 29 kg 465 grams of ganja was recovered from co-accused Shakil. His interrogation disclosed the name of Jamil. Said Jamil led the Police to Canter from which recovery of 29 kg of ganja was effected. The Canter belonged to Meena the wife of present petitioner. Meena has since been allowed bail. Even co-accused Jamil has since been allowed bail. As per the custody certificate placed on record, petitioner is in custody for the last 1 year 6 months and 13 days. He has no criminal antecedents.

Having regard to the aforesaid facts and circumstance and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, and the fact that trial may take time to conclude, petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing personal bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/ Vacation Judge concerned.
