Prayer in the present case was for seeking release of the security amount that had been forfeited by the respondents.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner fairly submits that the forfeiture has been ordered by the respondents on account of registration of FIR No. 0280 dated 30.09.2016 registered under Sections 379/420/467/468/471/120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 wherein the petitioner is an accused and that the question with regards to the entitlement of the petitioner to release of the security amount would depend on the final outcome of the criminal proceedings. He thus does not press, the instant case at this stage so as to approach this Court again and/or to take recourse to such alternative remedies as

are available to him in accordance with law on conclusion of the pending criminal proceedings.

Disposed of as not pressed at this stage with liberty as aforesaid.
