JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.90 dated 01.06.2022 registered under Sections 420/406 IPC, 1860 at Police Station City Phagwara, District Police Kapurthala.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 16.01.2023, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case but contends that the conduct of the petitioner in filing various petitions with different names and her criminal antecedents did not entitle her to the grant of bail.

Admittedly, the petitioner has joined investigation in the present case. Therefore, even though the conduct and antecedents of the

petitioner are not above board, no cause for custodial interrogation is made is out in the instant case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 16.01.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and she shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
