Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that petitioner was shortlisted out of all the candidates and thereafter, called for interview. The petitioner appeared in the interview on 01.06.2023. The petitioner has now been orally informed that post is going to be readvertized.

2. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that university

has taken a conscious decision not to appoint the petitioner and his

candidature has been turned down. Required report is already uploaded on the website of the university, however, he undertakes to supply copy of the decision of the Committee/Board within 7 days from today to the petitioner.

- 3. The petitioner on receipt of communication from respondent would be at liberty to avail remedy as permissible by law.
