Challenge in the present writ petition was to the approval granted by the Government dated 15.07.2019 bearing Memo No. 47/09/2019-4HB-II (Annexure P-1) and the consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Counsel for the respondents have informed that at the time of the filing of the present petition, only an order had been issued and eventually, vide notification bearing No. R.15021/04/2022-EMRB,

Regulation dated 10.05.2023 published in the Gazette of India, the Registration of Medical Practitioners and Licence to Practice Medicine, Regulations, 2023 is notified wherein the procedure for renewal of license has been duly incorporated.

Counsel for the petitioner thus does not press the instant petition at this stage and prays for opportunity to take recourse to the appropriate remedies in accordance with law so as to espouse all his grievances and objections to the clauses of Renewal of License to practice medicine as has been incorporated and notified under the Regulation dated 10.05.2023.
