1. The present petition has been filed by the Gram Panchayat Baggarian, Block Atari, District Amritsar, for seeking issuance of directions to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Amritsar Rural, to provide adequate police help.

2. Written statement on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 had been filed and as per which the dispute with respect to the land in question was pending before the Civil Judge, Senior (Sic) Division, Amritsar and currently before the Collector-cum-Divisional Deputy Director, Rural Development and Panchayat, Jalandhar, Camp at Amritsar and a stay has been granted against the petitioner and in favour of the private respondents. Besides, the petitioner never approached the respondents for seeking police help.

3. A separate short reply has been filed on behalf of respondents No.3 to

5 wherein it is submitted that the petitioner-Gram Panchayat, had leased out the land of 20 kanal and 04 marlas to Gurdeep Singh son of Jaswant Singh for the year 2016-17 by passing resolution dated 23.05.2016 (Annexure P-2).

4. Today there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

5. Successively for the last two dates, there has been no representation on behalf of the petitioner and the position has remained unchanged today as well.

6. It seems that the petitioner-Gram Panchayat is no more interested in pursuing the present writ petition.

7. Dismissed for non-prosecution.
