1. This writ petition in the nature of Certiorari is filed seeking directions to the respondents for renewing the licences of the petitioners who is 'Kacha Artiyas'.

2. While issuing the notice of motion on 22.09.2021 following order was passed:-

“Notice of motion.

Mr. Rajesh Gaur, Addl. AG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent No. 1 and Mr. Sandeep Moudgil, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 2 and 3 and seek time to file written statements.

Adjourned to 10.11.2021.

However, till the next date of hearing or till final decision is taken by the respondents on the applications moved by the petitioners for renewal of their licences, they will be permitted to operate at the places, they are working as on date.”

Learned counsel appearing for respondents on instructions

submit that decision in accordance with law on the application for renewal of licence would be taken within eight weeks from today, after providing opportunity of hearing to the petitioners.

4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, the petition is disposed of.

5. Let the petitioners appears before the office of respondent No. 3, on 20th March, 2023 at 11:00 AM. Petitioners may appear in person or through his representative.

6. The interim protection granted to the petitioners vide order dated 22.09.2021 shall continue for ten weeks from today i.e. during the pendency of the renewal application and two weeks thereafter to permit sufficient time to the petitioners for availing the remedies if aggrieved of the decision.

7. Since the main case has been decided, the pending application(s), if any is rendered infructuous.
