1. Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.190 dated 28.06.2023, registered under Sections 381, 411, 201, 120-B IPC, at Police Station Sector-14, District Panchkula.
2. Status report by way of affidavit dated 24.08.2023 of the Assistant Commissioner of Police, Panchkula Zone-II, already filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Vide order dated 17.07.2023, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 17.07.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
5. Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Ravinder Pal Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

6. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.
7. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 17.07.2023 granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
