The prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.87, dated 08.03.2022, under Sections 148, 149, 302 of IPC, 1860 and Sections 25, 54, 59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Julana, District Jind.

Vide order dated 10.08.2022, the petitioner was granted the interim protection.

Status report dated 07.02.2023 by way of an affidavit of Ravi Khundia, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Jind-Detective on behalf of the respondent-State has been filed today in the Court and the same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to the counsel opposite.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Samarjeet, 959, Jind, submits that in compliance of the order dated 10.08.2022, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. The weapon is already recovered from the co-accused. The allegation against the petitioner is that

he had supplied his licenced weapon with which the crime was committed, said weapon is recovered from co-accused and he is not required for any custodial interrogation.

In view of above, the order dated 10.08.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
