The petitioner is seeking regular bail by way of this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.33 dated 31.03.2021 registered under Section 22/29/61/85 NDPS Act registered at Police Station Moonak, District Sangrur.

2. As per allegations, 8800 loose tablets and 500 loose intoxicant capsules were recovered on 31.03.2021 from co-accused Sanjeev Kumar and during investigation he disclosed that he had to supply the said intoxicant substance to the petitioner and co-accused Sanjeev Kumar and Dinesh.

3. It is contended by learned counsel that petitioner has been arrested simply on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused. It is further pointed out that main accused Sanjeev Kumar from whom the recovery was effected has already been allowed regular bail by this Court vide order dated 01.07.2021 in CRM-M-23888-2021 (O&M) (Annexure P-3). Another co-accused Sukhdev Singh, who is similarly placed to that of the petitioner was allowed regular bail by this Court vide

order dated 12.08.2021 in CRM-M-30488-2021 (Annexure P-2).

- 4. Notice of motion.
- 5. Mr. M.S. Nagra, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent- State.
- 6. Learned State counsel could not refute the contentions raised by learned counsel for the petitioner. Custody certificate has been placed on record, as per which petitioner is in custody for the last 2 months and 1 day.
- 7. Having regard the aforesaid facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
