The prayer in the petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for directing the respondent no.2 to get the investigation completed in FIR No.593 dated 08.12.2021 under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC, Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar, Mohali from the regular IO because the respondent no.3 without any authority is sitting over the matter is not allowing the police to exercise the powers vested in them under the provisions of Section 156, 157 Cr.PC.

The Counsel for the petitioner at the very outset submits that two of the co-accused namely Gulshan Rai Satija and Prateek Satija are already in custody whereas the third has sought the concession of anticipatory bail and is on interim bail.

The Counsel for the State has responded and submits that two

accused are certainly in custody and report under Section 173(2) Cr.PC shall be submitted as expeditiously as possible.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.
