Petitioner has filed this civil writ petition under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, seeking directions to the respondents to grant her compassionate appointment pursuant to her application dated 25.05.2015, as her father Harmesh Lal after rendering 27 years of service, died on 12.07.2014 during active service.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by learned counsel that on the same cause of action, previously petitioner had filed CWP No.25374 of 2016 and the same was decided by this Court vide order dated 11.01.2019 (Annexure P-3), whereby direction was given to the respondents to consider petitioner's claim.

Learned counsel states that despite this direction, the petitioner's claim is still pending.

When confronted with the maintainability of the present writ petition, which is based upon the same cause of action pleaded in the earlier writ petition, learned counsel does not press this writ petition and prays for

withdrawal, in order to avail the alternative remedy in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
