Present civil revision petition has been filed challenging the order dated 19.02.2020 (Annexure P-1) by which the plaintiff/respondent No.1 was allowed to withdraw the suit with liberty to file a fresh one.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the said order dated 19.02.2020 is arbitrary, illegal and causing prejudice to the petitioner.

On being asked as to how the said order has caused prejudice to the petitioner, no valid justification has come forward. Rather, learned counsel for the petitioner very fairly conceded that the impugned order was passed approximately three years ago and even the fresh suit has already been filed in which notice has also been issued.

Keeping in view the fact that no illegality in the impugned order dated 19.02.2020 (Annexure P-1) could be pointed out and further a fresh suit has already been filed in which notice has already been issued to the petitioner, in the revisional jurisdiction, this Court will not like to interfere in the facts and circumstances of the present case qua the impugned order dated 19.02.2020 (Annexure P-1).
