In the present petition, various claims have been raised by the petitioners but at the time of arguments, only one claim has been pressed that the petitioners' case be considered for regularization of their services as VLDA from the date, they had initially joined.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the similar benefits have already been granted to the petitioners in CWP No. 4372 of 1996 titled as ***Mahabir Singh and others Vs. State of Haryana and others***, decided on 21.08.2023, hence the respondents are under obligation to consider the claim of the petitioners also for regularizing their services as VLDA from the date they had initially joined the department so that the petitioners are able to get the further benefit of ACP etc.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, any representation is filed by the petitioners claiming the benefit of regularization of their services as VLDA from an antedate, the same will be considered in accordance with law and the benefit granted to the petitioners in ***Mahabir Singh and others' case (supra)*** will also be kept in mind while passing the speaking order and appropriate order will be passed within period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such representation. Learned counsel for the respondents further submits that in case, the petitioners are found entitled for any benefit, the said benefit will be released to them within a further period of four weeks and the petitioners' claim for the consequential relief will also be considered, if any, they are found entitled for.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the said statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
